Waste Disposal Calendar

Take your waste in the designated bag to the collection area by 8:30 a.m. on the collection day.

Inashiki City (Shintone/Sakuragawa area)

- Each household may take up to five bags of combustible waste to the collection point each collection day.
- Tie the designated bag and place it in the designated area.

It's against the law to leave recyclables with other waste!!

Hours						◎ Monday through Friday/ From 8:40 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (Inquiries can be made at any time during these hours) ◎ Saturday/ 8:40 ~ 11:30 *Waste cannot be brought in on Saturday afternoons, Sundays, national holidays or from December 29th to January 3rd.						
Note for inquiries						◎ An inquiry must be made for each instance of waste. ◎ The facility will need to confirm the source of the waste. Bring documents that identify the person bringing in the waste, where the waste came from, etc.						
Other						◎ We may be unable to accept waste that is difficult for us to process properly. ◎ Please utilize collection points whenever possible.						
Processing fees						1. Processing fees ①Normal household waste: 100 yen per 10 kg (Up to 100 kg per day is accepted free) ②Industrial waste: 200 yen per 10 kg 2. Transportation costs Special kinds of household appliances (TVs, air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, driers): 2,000 yen per item *A recycle sticker is required. (Inquiries can only be made on weekdays) Refer to page 24 of the Waste Classification Guidebook for more details.
